We offer services to families, local authorities and education professionals.

Offering a variety of therapeutic approaches, including Dyadic Developmental Psychotherapy, Theraplay, VIG (Video Interaction Guidance) and the Nurtured Heart Approach™. Our experienced multi disciplinary team, which is made up of Therapeutic Social Workers and Occupational Therapists, works closely with families and professionals to equip them with the necessary knowledge, understanding and strategies needed to support their children at different points along their adoption journey.

We know that learning is an on-going process for all parents and especially for adoptive parents. Our experienced team will work with you to identify the best support for you whatever stage of the adoption journey you are. From April 2021 to March 2022, we have worked with 136 families. During that period, we also facilitated 49 webinars with a total of 1120 people enrolling onto them. Since our service begun, we have worked with over 100 Regional Adoption Agencies / Local Authorities across England.

We have facilitated training into nurseries, schools and colleges with the aim creating an 'attachment and trauma aware' community, so that children and young people experience the nurturing environments that they need to develop, grow and achieve. In 2021-22, we delivered 29 Reducing Anxiety Management Plans to Schools.
